Parents of students at ALL grade levels need to complete the district enrollment process at the Education and Administration Center (EAC)

- 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> grade is Tuesday, August 15, 2017

- Half-Time Kindergarten – Monday, Wednesday 8:15 a.m.-3:15p.m., Friday 8:15a.m.-11:15a.m.
- Morning preschool- 8:15 a.m. until 11:15 a.m.
- Afternoon preschool - 12:15 p.m. until 3:15 p.m.
- 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade - 7:45 a.m. - 2:45 p.m.

**Grades K - 5:**

- Parents of incoming Kindergarten through 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will be notified of their class placement at the K-8 Open House in August (see below for details).

- If you register your K-5<sup>th</sup> grade student after August 11, 2017 at the EAC, please call the Discovery Canyon Campus Elementary Office at 719-234-3800 to verify placement of your child in class.

### Grades 6 - 12:

  - Messages left between June 8th and August 1, 2017 will be returned by the end of the day August 1 to set up your appointment. Please leave your child's name, grade and a phone number where you can be contacted.
- **To insure proper placement for your student, you will need to bring a COPY of the following:**
  - ***Last report card or unofficial transcript*** (you must bring at least one of these two items)
  - State or local standardized test results if possible
  - 504 or IEP if applicable
  - Talented and Gifted documents if applicable

### **Elementary Supply Fees and Consumable Fee for 17-18 School Year **\*\*Important News\*\*****

Last school year, a task force of parents, teachers, and administrators reviewed student fees at the direction of Superintendent Dr. Mark Hatchell. During this process, parents and school administrators asked about possibly eliminating elementary and middle classroom school supply lists and instead charge a fee for classroom school supplies. After researching this process and realizing that efficiencies will increase and the net cost to parents would decrease, this procedure has been implemented with the adoption of the student fee schedule.

Students and parents benefit from the tax exempt status and volume purchasing power of the school district. Teachers can purchase the exact supplies they use and the school can retain and reuse supplies that are useful for multiple years.

- ***Classroom supply fee for DCCES is \$35*** and will be collected in the fall when students return. Parents won't

need to find a supply list for a particular grade level or teacher and will not need to purchase classroom school supplies on their own.

- **Classroom consumable fee for DCCES is \$35** and will be collected in the fall when students return. This fee will include items such as class t-shirts, classroom magazine subscriptions, planners, etc.

### High School Check-In Information

#### **All freshmen will have vision and hearing tests**

Students in grade 9 will need to take care of the following items during their designated check-in time. Check-in will take approximately 30 minutes. Please drop your student off at the High School entrance. Student IDs and yearbook pictures will take place in the HS gym. (Please dress appropriately)

- PE Uniforms (all students are required to wear a PE uniform)
  - Fees  
(Class fees will be added to all student accounts in Aug/Fall Semester, Jan/Spring Semester)
  - Planner
  - Yearbook (\$70)
  - Lunch accounts (Sodexo lunch prices attached)
  - All Freshmen will need to have a vision and hearing screening
  - Student Activity Pass (athletics only) (\$40)
  - Family Activity Pass (\$175) - covers five people, no more than two adults. Children K-12. Additional family passes are available for students (I-12) for \$30. Adult Pass, \$55, Family members of college age or older must buy adult pass for \$55.
