- Parents of students at ALL grade levels need to complete the district enrollment process at the Education and Administration Center (EAC)

 - Morning preschool- 8:15 a.m. until 11:15 a.m.
 - Afternoon preschool - 12:15 p.m. until 3:15 p.m.
 - 9th – 12th grade - 7:45 a.m. - 2:45 p.m.

- Bus route information and times are available through the “extended” parent portal. Parents may view this information now on IC, with the understanding that the transportation department is still adding stops as deemed necessary. Parents are encouraged to check the extended parent portal frequently the week before school starts for any changes to their bus routes that may include a time change. Grades K - 5:

- Parents of incoming Kindergarten through 5th grade students will be notified of their class placement at the K-5 Open House in August (see below for details).
- If you register your K-5th grade student after August 10, 2017 at the EAC, please call the Discovery Canyon Campus Elementary Office at 719-234-3800 to verify placement of your child in class.

Grades 6-12:

Messages left between June 11th and August 1, 2018 will be returned by the end of the day August 1st to set up an appointment with your students' counselor. Please leave your child's name, grade and a phone number where we can reach you.

- To insure proper placement for your student, you will need to bring a COPY of the following:**
- Last report card or unofficial transcript (you must bring at least one of these two items)*
- State or local standardized test results if possible
- 504 or IEP if applicable
- Talented and Gifted documents if applicable

Here is what you will find at the Open House:

- o **Elementary (Grades K-5)**

Elementary Supply Fees and Consumable Fee for 18-19 School Year

High School Check-In Information

9th Grade

Check-In-August 14

All freshmen will have vision and hearing tests

Students in grade 9 will need to take care of the following items during their designated check-in time. Check-in will take approximately 30 minutes. Please drop your student off at the High School entrance. Student IDs and yearbook pictures will take place in the HS gym. (Please dress appropriately)

- PE Uniforms (all students are required to wear a PE uniform)
- Fees
(Please watch your student accounts in *Aug/Fall Semester, Jan/Spring Semester* for student fees)
- Planner
- Yearbook (\$70)
- Lunch accounts (Sodexo lunch prices attached)
- All Freshmen will need to have a vision and hearing screening
- Student Activity Pass (athletics only) (\$40)
- Family Activity Pass (\$175) - covers five people, no more than two adults. Children K-12. Additional family passes are available for students (1-12) for \$30.
Adult Pass, \$55, Family members of college age or older must buy adult pass for \$55.

Fall sports registration will begin on Monday 7/16– online through the Extended Parent Portal. All information will be on the DCC HS Athletic website, <https://dcchigh.asd20.org> then click on the *Athletic tile* on the right side of the website.

ALL Fall sports will begin on Monday, August 6th (new change from CHSAA).
